A BILL To extend programs of assistance for elementary and secondary education and for other purposes

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, That this Act may be cited as the "Elementary and Secondary Education Amendments of 1969."

EXTENSION OF PROVISIONS RELATING TO SCHOOLS FOR INDIAN CHILDREN

SEC. 2. The third sentence of section 103(a) (1) (A) of the Act of September 30, 1950 (Public Law 874, Eighty-first Congress), is amended by striking out "June 30, 1968, and the fiscal year ending June 30, 1969" and inserting in lieu thereof "June 30, 1968, and each of the next seven fiscal years".

FIXING THE FORMULA FACTORS FOR THE PERIOD OF EXTENSION

SEC. 3. The second sentence of section 103(c) of the Act of September 30, 1950 (Public Law 874, Eighty-first Congress), is amended to read as follows: "Except as otherwise provided in section 108, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1968, and for each succeeding fiscal year, they shall be 50 per centum and \$3,000, respectively."

EXTENSION OF SPECIAL INCENTIVE GRANTS

SEC. 4. Section 121(d) of the Act of September 30, 1950 (Public Law 874, Eighty-first Congress), is amended to read as follows: "(d) For the purpose of making grants under this part there are authorized to be appropriated not in excess of \$50,000,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1969, and for each of the six succeeding fiscal years."

EXTENDING PROVISIONS RELATING TO SCHOOLS FOR INDIAN CHILDREN AND DEFENSE DEPARTMENT OVERSEAS DEPENDENT SCHOOLS IN TEXTBOOK AND LIBRARY RESOURCE PROGRAM

SEC. 5. Section 202(a) (1) of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965 is amended by striking out "June 30, 1968, and the fiscal year ending June 30, 1969" and inserting in lieu thereof "June 30, 1968, and each of the next succeeding seven fiscal years".
